BE IT RESOLVED that the Aurora City Council hereby adopts the budget on file in the office of the City Recorder.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Aurora City Council hereby levies the taxes provided for in the budget adopted in paragraph 1 of this resolution in the aggregate amount of Thirty nine thousand eight hundred sixty three dollars (\$39,863) and that these taxes are hereby levied upon all taxable property within the City of Aurora as of 1 AM January 1, 1984.

BE IT RESOLVED that the amounts for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1984 to June 30, 1985 and for the purposes shown below are hereby appropriated as follows:
