

RESOLUTION NO. 114

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR AN ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF AURORA, MARION COUNTY, OREGON, ON THE 6th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1984, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED LEGAL VOTERS OF SAID CITY THE QUESTION OF ADOPTING A NEW CITY CHARTER.

WHEREAS, the Aurora City Council has determined that a new city charter should be enacted, and

WHEREAS, a citizens committee was appointed to revise and update the city charter, and

WHEREAS, a copy of that proposed new city charter will be on file in the office of the city recorder, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to submit the question of enacting a new charter to the legal voters of the City of Aurora, Oregon, now therefore,

THE CITY OF AURORA HEREBY RESOLVES THAT:

Section 1. The measure set forth in Section 2 shall be submitted in the manner prescribed herein to the legal voters of the City of Aurora at a city election to be held on November 6, 1984.

Section 2. At the city election there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Aurora for their approval or rejection the following measure:

ENACTING A NEW CITY CHARTER

SHALL THE CITY OF AURORA ENACT A NEW CITY CHARTER ?

THE PURPOSE OF ENACTING A NEW CITY CHARTER IS TO UPDATE THE CHARTER IN ORDER TO PERMIT THE PROPER OPERATION OF CITY AFFAIRS.

Yes, I vote in favor of a new charter


No, I vote against a new charter

Section 3. The City Recorder for the City of Aurora shall cause notice of the charter election to be posted in three public and conspicuous places in the City of Aurora for not less than 20 days before the election; and said recorder shall also post with the notice of said election, a full and complete copy of the proposed new charter.
