

RESOLUTION NO. 117

CITY OF AURORA

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GARBAGE COLLECTION RATE INCREASE AND ESTABLISHING A NEW RATE SCHEDULE:

Under Ordinance No. 249 for the City of Aurora, UNITED DISPOSAL SERVICE, INC. has the exclusive Franchise to provide Solid Waste Management in the City, including collecting, transporting, and conveying Solid Waste over the streets of the City, disposal of said waste, or recovery of materials or energy from said Solid Waste.

The Franchisee has applied to the City for a Rate Increase to cover the increased cost of disposal and franchise fees as a result of the garbage burner being built in Marion County, wherein disposal fees are to be increased from \$4 per ton to \$12 per ton on or about March 1, 1985. The Franchisee has submitted satisfactory evidence to the City Council to justify the requested Rates.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the maximum rates charged by UNITED DISPOSAL SERVICE, INC. in the City of Aurora shall be those Rates set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" which is incorporated by reference in this Resolution. These new Rates shall become effective March 1, 1985.
