RESOLUTION No. 139

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, CHIEF OF POLICE, AND THE CHIEF OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF AURORA TO EXECUTE AND ENDORSE AN AGREEMENT ACCEPTING THE COMBINED 911 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM PLAN FOR THE WOODBURN PSAP, AND AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF SAME WITH THE STATE OF OREGON EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DIVISION.

WHEREAS, ORS 401.720 requires all public and private safety agencies to participate in a 911 emergency telephone system by January 1, 1991, and ORS 401.740 requires local jurisdictions to submit a preliminary plan for said emergency telephone system by January 1, 1987, and

WHEREAS agencies in the Woodburn PSAP have determined through meetings during the last year that a 911 emergency telephone system with the answering point in Woodburn is the preferred service operation in this jurisdictional area, and

WHEREAS support and committment is necessary to establish 911 emergency telephone service and receive supporting 911 telephone tax monies held in trust for system services, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Aurora City Council that the Mayor, Police Chief, and Fire Chief are authorized to execute and endorse an agreement with the City of Woodburn and other participating agencies in the Woodburn PSAP to provide for the installation and resulting services provided by the agreement in a 911 emergency telephone system plan. Filing of the 911 emergency telephone system plan is authorized with the State of Oregon Emergency Management Division.
