

RESOLUTION NO. 211

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENT OF THE AURORA CITY COUNCIL TO MAKE A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT; TO LEVY AND COLLECT SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS THEREFORE; AND DIRECTING THE CITY ENGINEER TO MAKE A SURVEY OF THE IMPROVEMENT.


WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has been awarded \$373,704 in lottery funds from the Special Public Works Fund (SPWF), administered by the Oregon Economic Development Department, and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Economic Development Department has determined that a portion of the loan funds, in the amount of \$99,704, should be repaid through the levying of special assessments to the property owners specially benefiting from the infrastructure improvements through the formation of a Local Improvement District (LID), now therefore


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AURORA CITY COUNCIL:

1. The intent to make a local improvement in the City of Aurora is hereby declared. The local improvement shall consist of the construction of a new water reservoir and the construction of a new street, Ottaway Road NE, located on the west side of Highway 99E.
2. The intent to levy and collect special assessments from the owners of property specially benefiting from the improvement, in the principal amount \$99,704, over a term of twenty years, at an interest rate of 5%, is hereby declared.
3. The City Engineer is hereby directed to make a survey of the improvement, and to file a written report with the City Recorder which meets all requirements of Ordinance No. 297, Section 3.
4. The map illustrating the boundary of the Local Improvement District is attached to, and a part of, this Resolution.
