

RESOLUTION NUMBER 573

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY RECORDER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH WEBER CONSULTING, AS A TEMPORARY CONSULTANT TO RESTORE THE SPRINGBROOK BACK-UP, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Aurora City Council has determined that an emergency exists with the inability of current systems and contract resources to adequately provide back up or restore data contained in the Springbrook software program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has determined that Weber Consulting can provide these services on an immediate and temporary basis; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has established that the secured back-up program be stored off-site at a secured location should restoration of the financial program, the water utility billing program and associated data, if the Springbrook software server goes down for any reason.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AURORA THAT: that the City Recorder is authorized to enter into a contract with Weber Consulting for not more that \$100 an hour to provide secure back up and restoration of the data on the City computer systems in particular the Springbrook system. Because the City Council has declared an emergency, the City Recorder may enter into the contract immediately.

ADOPTED by the Aurora City Council at a Special City Council meeting held on Tuesday, March 24, 2009. This resolution is effective March 24, 2009.
