RESOLUTION NO. 579

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AURORA, OREGON,
AMENDING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM WITHOUT AFFECTING
SYSTEMS DEVELOPMENT CHARGES**

WHEREAS, on July 14, 2000, the City of Aurora adopted Ordinance No. 403 (later codified in AMC 13.16.010 *et seq.*) establishing the methodology and procedural requirements for imposition of systems development charges; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora at the same time adopted its Capital Improvement Program which indicated approximate dollar values for planned projects which might be funded by systems development charges; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance permits the City Council to amend the Capital Improvement Plan by Resolution without advanced notice mailed to interested persons so long as the amendments do not result in higher systems development charges; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined additional classifications within the Capital Improvement Program should be eligible for systems development charges funding;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AURORA THAT:

Section 1. The Transportation Table of the Capital Improvement Program is amended to add Section 1.7 - Street Capacity Improvements with a total 20 year amount of \$105,000.

Section 2. The total 20 year amount of Line 1.3 - Pave Gravel Streets of the Transportation Table of the Capital Improvement Program is reduced by \$105,000.

Section 3. Additional amendments to Line 1.3, Line 1.7, and section totals are as follows displayed on Attachment "A" which is attached to and by reference made a part of this resolution.

Section 4. With those amendments, the City Council re-adopts the Capital Improvement Program.

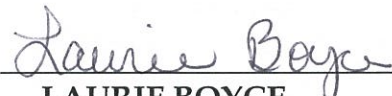

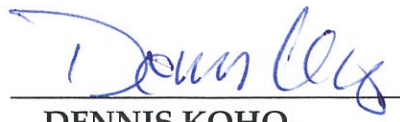
