A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora owns two older 1997 Chevrolet 2500 trucks that were formerly used by the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora no longer has a use for the trucks; and

WHEREAS, the trucks are surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the funds received from sale of the trucks will benefit the City of Aurora;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AURORA THAT: that the Mayor, Bill Graupp, is authorized to sell the 1997 trucks in a reasonable and efficient manner, either through public auction, private sale, or any other method of his choosing, that will likely result in the City obtaining the highest and best value for the trucks.

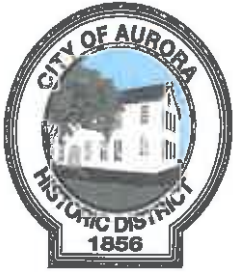
