If you choose to pay your bill with a credit or debit card, there is a small convenience charge of \$3.50 for each transaction. This site also provides the option to sign up for electronic bill delivery.

- The City is only responsible for repairs and water leaks in the city right-of-way only.

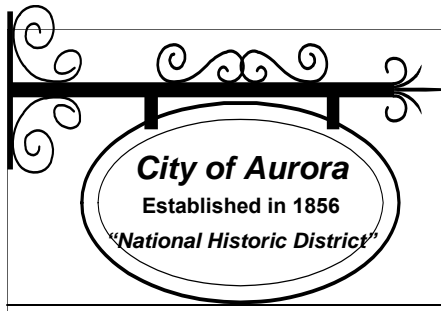

Home Projects this Summer?

If your home or business is within the Historic Overlay Zone, remember that ALL EXTERIOR CHANGES to your property may need prior approval. You can easily review what is required as well as find guidance in the new spiral-bound *Design Guide for Historic District Properties* that you received a year ago. Not all exterior changes require a formal review by the Historic Review Board, but instead may be authorized by city staff in the office. Your property's category will determine what standards to follow.

Should your changes require an HRB review, please give yourself enough time to make application for their meetings which are held the 4th Thursday of each month. You are also always welcome to attend these meetings and ask for any advice or suggestions on how to make alterations, present ideas prior to application or other restoration issues.
