The City of Aurora Announces Open Mayor and Council

- 2 Council seats—4 year term
- Mayor position—2 year term



Candidacy may be declared by any city resident (6 month residency minimum). If you are interested, please pick up an elections filing packet which will be available for you on June 1st 2012, between the hours of 9:00 am and 4:00 pm at Aurora City Hall, 21420 Main Street, NE. Deadline for submissions are Friday,

August 18, 2012 by 4:30 pm.

Recently the City has made some changes to the water billing due dates and fee schedule, in hopes to help make the process easier and less costly. The updates are as follows:

- 1. Due date will now be the 10th of the month instead of the 25th
- Courtesy notices will go out on or about the 20th depending on what day it falls on (which does have a late fee of \$15.00 attached)
- Water shut offs will be schedule approx 5 days later, a door hanger notice is now \$45.00 dollars and water will be shut off at that time.

This is meant to impact the habitual late payments, not to impact the majority of the citizens who pay their bill on time. At the same time to make due dates more consistent and easier to remember.

We get many calls stating they did not receive their bill. If you do not see it by the 4th of the month call us and we can provide you with a copy. Please remember that if you need to pay every month for budgeting purposes it simply shows as a credit on your billing statement.

Billing Months are as follow;

January-February due on March 10th
March-April due on May 10th
May-June due on July 10th
July-August due on September 10th
September-October due on November 10th
November-December due on January 10th

Piano Concert at Charbonneau Country Club

Edward J. Finck, the oldest son of the Aurora Colony Music teacher Henry Conrad Finck, was a piano teacher and composer in Portland from the mid 1870's to his death in 1916. Finck's obituary noted that he left "volumes of music still in manuscript form, including symphonic works."

Through the generosity of Barbara Van Lieu and Elinor Golding, descendants of the Finck family, nearly thirty of these manuscripts have been donated to the Aurora Colony Historical Society. Selections of these manuscripts will be played for the first time in a public setting by local musicians. Concurrently, vocals and string instruments will fill out the program.

The concert is being organized for ACHS by Andrew Willette who has been in charge of the Aurora Colony's Oregon Music project for several years. A light dessert will be included.
