RESOLUTION No. 552

This matter came before the Aurora City Council at its regularly scheduled public meeting on May 13, 2008, to consider approving a Law Enforcement Use of Deadly Force Response Plan.

WHEREAS, the 2007 Oregon Legislature enacted Senate Bill 111 (Oregon Laws 2007 Chap. 842)) creating in each county a deadly physical force planning authority and requiring each planning authority to develop a plan consisting of elements dealing with education, outreach and training, the immediate aftermath, investigation, exercise of district attorney discretion, and collecting information regarding the use of deadly physical force and an estimate of the fiscal impact on law enforcement agencies to which the plan applies; and

WHEREAS, the Marion County Use of Deadly Physical Force Planning Authority has prepared a plan that includes these elements and held a properly noticed public hearing on the plan on March 11, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the plan meets the requirements of Senate Bill 111 and that it is in the interests of Marion County and its residents to approve the plan; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Council approves the Law Enforcement Use of Deadly Physical Force Response Plan submitted by

the Marion County Use of Deadly Physical Force Planning Authority.
