

RESOLUTION NUMBER 625

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING POLICY ON ALCOHOL IN CITY PARKS

WHEREAS, the Aurora citizens who use the city park and their guests sometimes desire an opportunity to have or serve alcohol; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that the consumption of alcohol in city parks should be allowed so long as the use is prudent and carefully regulated; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to announce the policy on use of alcohol in city parks during the time when citizens often reserve days in which they intend to use the park;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AURORA THAT:

Consumption of alcoholic beverages in city parks is permitted so long as:


- The only alcoholic beverages permitted in city parks are beer and wine;
- Consumption is limited to only those persons who are of legal age;
- Park visitors who serve alcohol to others must possess the appropriate permits from the Oregon Liquor Control Commission and liability insurance for the event of at least \$1,000,000.00 with the City of Aurora named as a loss payee;
- Park visitors may consumer beer or wine bring to the park for their personal consumption; and
- Park visitors must at all times comply with all park rules and conduct themselves in a way that does not offend other users of the park.

ADOPTED by the Aurora City Council at a City Council meeting held on Tuesday, April 12, 2011. This resolution is effective April 12, 2011.
