

RESOLUTION NUMBER 647

A RESOLUTION DECLARING INTENT TO ASSUME PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION

WHEREAS, the program administration for building permits, including electrical, structural, mechanical, plumbing and is are currently performed by Marion County on the behalf of the City of Aurora; and

WHEREAS, Marion County also processes the permit applications for the City; and

WHEREAS, the City believes it can provide these services to its customers more promptly, effectively, courteously, and without putting customers at risk for fee increases; and


WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has notified the State of Oregon, Building Codes Division of its desire and intent to assume the administration of these programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AURORA THAT: The Mayor, City Attorney, and other necessary staff are authorized to file any required applications and documents with the State of Oregon in furtherance of the City's desire to assume administration of these programs.

AND BE IT RESOLVED THAT: If the City's application is approved, the City, its employees, and its agents involved in administering the program shall at all times comply with state law in the conduct of the program and in particular comply with and be bound by the Electrical Delegation Rules.


ADOPTED by the Aurora City Council at a City Council meeting held on Tuesday, March 13, 2012. This resolution is effective upon passage.
