BE IT RESOLVED that the Aurora City Council hereby levies the taxes provided for in the budget adopted in paragraph 1 of this resolution in the aggregate amount of thirty three thousand seven hundred forty seven (\$33,747) and that these taxes are hereby levied upon all taxable property within the City of Aurora as of 1 AM July 1, 1981.
