BE IT RESOLVED that the Aurora City Council hereby adopts the budget now on file in the office of the City Recorder.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Aurora City Council hereby levies the taxes provided for in the budget adopted in paragraph 1 of this resolution in the aggregate amount of Twenty nine thousand nine hundred ninety eight dollars (\$29,998) and that these taxes are hereby levied upon all taxable property within the City of Aurora as of 1 A.M. January 1, 1982.

BE IT RESOLVED that the amounts for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982 to June 30, 1983 and for the purposes shown below are hereby appropriated as follows:
