A RESOLUTION REQUESTING SURRENDER OF JURISDICTION OF A CERTAIN STREET FROM MARION COUNTY.

WHEREAS portions of Main Street, as herein described and indicated in red on the attached map marked Exhibit "A" has for many years been a Marion County road, MR 96; and

WHEREAS pursuant to ORS 373.270, the Board of Commissioners for Marion County, Oregon, can surrender jurisdiction over any County road or portion thereof within the corporate limits of any city; and

WHEREAS, Marion County has agreed to resurface the outer 12 feet on each side of Main Street from the city limits to 99E, remove the 45 foot long bump located 70 feet north of Second Street, stripe the street for diagonal parking, stripe a crosswalk at 2nd Street, remove two ramps on Main Street and fill and berm the inlet on Main Street or relocate the inlet; and

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AURORA DO RESOLVE that it is expedient and for the best interests of the City to acquire jurisdiction over Main Street within the city limits to the same extent as it has over other public streets of the City.

THEREFORE the Common Council does respectively request that the Marion County Board of Commissioners to surrender jurisdiction of Main Street within the corporate city limits of Aurora after completing the above mentioned improvements.
