A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF AURORA TO MAKE AN APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT (DLCD) FOR AN ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES ANALYSIS (EOA) FOR THE AURORA STATE AIRPORT

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) grant programs have funding for various grants, including Technical Assistance, Planning Assistance, and Periodic Review; and

WHEREAS, The City of Aurora proposes to evaluate the unique economic opportunities and constraints at the Aurora State Airport (ASA), including the potential for expansion of the Aurora urban growth boundary to enable increased aviation employment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora qualifies for Technical Assistance grant funding and wishes to apply for funding to assist with completion Economic Opportunities Analysis (EOA) associated with the Aurora State Airport and update components of the Aurora Comprehensive Plan's Economy Element (Statewide Planning Goal 9).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Aurora City Council as follows:

Section 1. Authorization to Apply for Funding

The City Council of Aurora hereby grants authority to the Mayor and City Planner to apply for Technical Assistance grant funding from the Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development on the City's behalf

Section 2. Effective Date

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval by the City Council.
