A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A WORKING CAPITAL FUND FOR THE COST OF PLANNING, INSTALLATION, OPERATION AND IMPROVEMENT OF A FUTURE EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF AURORA CALLED THE 9-1-1 FUND.

BE IT RESOLVED that a working capital fund of \$3,597.00, to be known as the 9-1-1 Fund, shall be established for the purpose of planning, installation, operation and improvement of a future emergency telephone system in the City of Aurora.

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Recorder shall have charge of the Fund and see that it is administered in accordance with the laws of the State, the Ordinances of the City, and generally accepted municipal accounting principals.

BE IT RESOLVED that the replenishment of the Fund shall be accomplished by quarterly pro-rated shares received by the City from the Executive Department of the State of Oregon.

BE IT RESOLVED that the effective date of action shall be retroactive to January 1, 1985.
