BE IT RESOLVED the Aurora City Council hereby adopts the budget on file in the office of the City Recorder.

BE IT RESOLVED the Aurora City Council hereby levies the taxes provided for in the budget adopted in paragraph 1 of this resolution in the aggregate amount of Forty-two thousand, three hundred, eighty-one dollars (\$42,381) and that these taxes are hereby levied upon all taxable property within the City of Aurora as of 1:00 AM, January 1, 1985.


