

RESOLUTION NO. 141

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF DISPATCH SERVICES FOR THE AURORA POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Aurora finds that a transfer of dispatch services is to be made from the Salem Metropolitan Communications Agency to the North Marion Communications Center for the purposes of implementing the 911 emergency telephone system by April 1, 1987, and


WHEREAS, the Aurora Police Department is one of the agencies to be participating in the 911 system and transfer of dispatch services, and is presently dispatched by the Salem Metropolitan Communications Agency, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that an orderly transition period is necessary to ensure the safe and effective transfer of police dispatch services from the Salem Metropolitan Communications Agency to the North Marion Communications Center presently located at the Woodburn Police Department,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Aurora, that the Chief of Police be authorized to enter into and execute an agreement with the City of Woodburn Police Department for transitional police dispatch services to be provided by the Woodburn Police Department effective February 1, 1987, and to terminate police dispatch services now being provided by the Salem Metropolitan Communications Agency effective February 1, 1987.
