A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS WITHIN THE POLICE BUDGET, AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF A SURPLUS POLICE VEHICLE, AND THE PURCHASE OF A POLICE VEHICLE FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora finds it necessary to replace a 1982 Dodge Diplomat police vehicle presently owned and operated by the Aurora Police Department, and

WHEREAS replacement funds are presently not available under Capital Outlay in the Aurora Police Department budget, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Aurora, Oregon, that the amount of \$550.00 be transferred from the General Operating Contingency Fund (Police Budget) to Capital Outlay (Police Budget), for the purpose of purchasing and outfitting a replacement police vehicle. The Aurora Police Department is also authorized to sell under sealed bid to the highest bidder, the 1982 Dodge Diplomat presently owned by the City of Aurora.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the City reserves the right to reject any and all bids received.
