

RESOLUTION NO. 173

A RESOLUTION TO INITIATE PROCEEDINGS FOR THE VACATION OF THE CITY ALLEY DESCRIBED HEREIN, SAID ALLEY BEING LOCATED IN THE 21100 BLOCK OF LIBERTY STREET IN THE CITY OF AURORA; AND FIXING A DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the city alley described hereunder is a dedicated public thoroughfare, to-wit:

That alley located between Marion County Tax Assessor's Account Numbers 40581-000 (R. Olsen), 40580-000 (Dr. John Green), 40575-000 (Rodger Eddy) and 40576-000 (Rodger Eddy), which alley is 20 feet in width and extends easterly from the center line of Liberty Street a distance of 269.58 feet to a dead end terminus at the westerly property line of a tract of land owned by Gene and Barbara Kretz (Tax Account #40572-000).

and

WHEREAS, the Aurora City Council has initiated vacation proceedings authorized by ORS 271.080, and consent of property owners is not required, as provided in ORS 271.130; and

WHEREAS, said alley is not improved as a public thoroughfare, has never been used for street purposes, and access from Liberty Street is blocked by a tree; and


WHEREAS, the Aurora City Council has investigated the matter and has determined it to be in the best interests of the City and the inhabitants thereof if said alley were in fact vacated; and there is no need for the alley to remain of record as a public thoroughfare, SAVE AND EXCEPT the westerly 30 feet which is part of Liberty Street; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the city alley described herein and shown by the plat thereof should be vacated so that the title to the same shall attach to the lands bordering on such area as provided in Oregon Revised Statutes 271.140.

BE IT RESOLVED, a public hearing on the question of such vacation is hereby called to be held at the Aurora City Hall, 21420 Main Street NE, Aurora, Marion County, Oregon at 7:30 PM on Tuesday, September 27, 1988, at which hearing the Aurora City Council shall hear and consider any objections to or remonstrances against the proposed vacation.


BE IT RESOLVED, the Aurora City Recorder shall cause notice of the petition and public hearing to be published once per week for four consecutive weeks in the Canby Herald, and shall cause "NOTICE OF ALLEY VACATION" to be posted in the manner prescribed in ORS 271.110 not less than twenty-eight (28) days prior to the date of public hearing.
