

RESOLUTION NO. 104

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, HIGHWAY DIVISION, TO DESIGNATE SPECIFIC PARKING AREAS ON HIGHWAY 99E NE WITHIN THE AURORA CITY LIMITS; AND TO ERECT APPROPRIATE SIGNAGE.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation is constructing a bikeway and signage, left-turn refuge lane and crosswalk project in the City of Aurora on Highway 99E NE; and

WHEREAS, said project requires authorization by the Aurora City Council to amend the existing parking structure along Highway 99E within the Aurora City Limits; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, the Aurora City Council hereby authorizes the Oregon Department of Transportation, Highway Division to designate parking on Highway 99E NE as follows:

The West side of Highway 99E, from First Street to Main Street, shall be "No Parking" with the exception of two parallel parking spaces in front 21617/21627 Highway 99E NE. (Presently known as Time After Time).

The West side of Highway 99E, from the south side of Main Street, south to and including 21477 Highway 99E, shall be designated as "Parallel Parking Only".

The West side of Highway 99E south from 21477 Highway 99E to the south city limits shall be designated "No Parking", due to the bikeway.

The East side of Highway 99E from the north city limits to Second Street shall be designated "No Parking".

The East side of Highway 99E from the South side of Second Street to Main Street shall be designated as "Parallel Parking Only", which includes the address 21568 Highway 99E NE (presently known as the Halfway Tavern).

The East side of Highway 99E, from the south side of Main Street to the south side of Third Street shall be designated "No Parking".


The East side of Highway 99E, from the South side of Third Street to the North side of Fourth Street shall be designated as "Parallel Parking Only".

The East side of Highway 99E, from the South side of Fourth Street to the south City Limits shall be designated as "No Parking".

In no case shall any parking space be located within twenty feet of a designated crosswalk.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Oregon Department of Transportation, Highway Division shall supply all appropriate signage including signage for affected businesses to place on buildings where necessary to indicate proper parking. Appropriate signage to include "No Parking" and "Parallel Parking Only".
