RESOLUTION NO. 210

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING MONTHLY WATER USER FEES FOR ALL USERS OF THE CITY WATER SYSTEM OF AURORA, OREGON, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A NEW WATER RESERVOIR; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has been awarded Special Public Works Funds in a combination grant and loan from the Oregon Economic Development Department, which in part will pay for the construction of a new water reservoir to augment the City's water system; and

WHEREAS, the loan portion of the award which is designated for the construction of the new reservoir must be re-paid in annual payments of \$11,017 for twenty years; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon and the Aurora City Council have determined that the new reservoir will benefit every user of the City water system, and that every user of the City water system will share equally in the re-payment of the loan; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AURORA CITY COUNCIL:

- A Water User Fee is hereby established, in the amount of \$3.20 per water user, per month.
- Multiple residential or commercial accounts shall pay the water user fee on a per unit basis. For example, a triplex sharing a common water meter will be charged \$9.60 per month.
- 3. The Water User Fees collected shall be maintained in a special account, and shall be used only for the annual loan payment to the State of Oregon, Special Public Works Fund, Economic Development Department.
- 4. The Water User Fees established herein shall be effective, retroactive to January 1, 1991, and shall appear on the January/February, 1991 water billings, as the first annual payment is due and payable January 1, 1992.
- The Water User Fees will be reviewed not less than once per year, and adjustments made due to the addition of new services to the City's water system.

ADOPTED by the Aurora City Council at a regularly scheduled meeting thereof on the 26th day of February, 1991.
