A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CONTINUATION OF THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, Oregon Governor Barbara Roberts and Jack Kemp, Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, have proclaimed the week of April 1-7, 1991 to be Community Development Week; and
