

RESOLUTION NO. 223

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EXEMPTION FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR A PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT, PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 240, SECTION 3.

WHEREAS, the Aurora City Council, in its capacity as local Contract Review Board, has considered bids received for the excavation, installation and backfill for water mains (PACKAGE #1) for the Special Public Works Fund Project, and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined to be in the public interest to reject both bids received, as such bids are considered to be excessive, and

WHEREAS, the competitive bidding process has been pursued twice, and it has been determined that the exemption of this contract from competitive bidding will not result in favoritism, but will result in substantial cost savings; and,


WHEREAS, the interest of the City would be materially benefited by immediate contract for the installation of the water mains; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED:

- (1) The Aurora City Council, as local Contract Review Board, hereby declares the excavation work for the installation of water mains (Package #1) of the Special Public Works Fund Project to be exempt from competitive bidding requirements.
- (2) Staff is hereby authorized to enter into negotiations to obtain a contract for the work described in Package #1, provided, however, the proposed contract is submitted to the Contract Review Board for approval prior to execution.
