A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EXEMPTION FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR A PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT, PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 240, SECTION 3.

WHEREAS, the Aurora City Council, in its capacity as local Contract Review Board, has considered the bid received for the construction of a building to house the booster pump station (PACKAGE #2) for the Special Public Works Fund Project, and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined said bid is not in compliance with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements, and is therefore rejected, and

WHEREAS, the competitive bidding process has been pursued twice, and it has been determined that the exemption of this contract from competitive bidding will not result in favoritism, but will result in substantial cost savings; and,

WHEREAS, the interest of the City would be materially benefited by immediate contract for the construction of the pump station building; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED:

- (1) The Aurora City Council, as local Contract Review Board, hereby declares the excavation work for the construction of the pump station building (Package #2) of the Special Public Works Fund Project to be exempt from competitive bidding requirements.
 - (2) Staff is hereby authorized to enter into negotiations to obtain a contract for the work described in Package #2, provided, however, the proposed contract is submitted to the Contract Review Board for approval prior to execution.
