

RESOLUTION NO. 234

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 218; ADOPTING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1991-92; AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Aurora City Council has caused the abatement of a declared nuisance of a hazardous structure, which nuisance was located at 21491 Main Street NE, Aurora, Marion County, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, related administrative, litigation and physical abatement costs were unanticipated in the Fiscal Year 1991-92 Budget; and

WHEREAS, an inter-fund loan has been authorized by resolution of the Council to pay such expenses from City funds; and

WHEREAS, unanticipated grant revenue has been awarded to the Police Department for new equipment; and

WHEREAS, unanticipated grant revenue has been awarded to the Street Fund for improvements to Ottaway Road; now therefore




