RESOLUTION NO. 241

A RESOLUTION ORDERING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE LOCAL IMPROVEMENT OF REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AURORA, OREGON.

WHEREAS, a local improvement of repairing or replacing existing sidewalks in the city, which existing sidewalks have been deemed to be unsafe for pedestrian traffic, and construction of one new sidewalk, as required by the Development Code Ordinance, have been ordered by the Aurora City Council; and

WHEREAS, the repairing or replacing of existing sidewalks, and the construction of one new sidewalk, will benefit a total of forty-two owners of property, said owners and benefited properties identified by Marion County Assessor's Tax Account Numbers attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the owners of two-thirds of the property that will benefit by the local improvement have by written petition requested that the City Council initiate the improvement through the formation of a Local Improvement District; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer's Report has been approved and intent to make the improvement declared by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, written remonstrances and oral objections to the improvement have been heard by the City Council, at a duly scheduled public hearing, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 343, Section 6; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED:

- The Aurora City Council hereby orders the construction of the local improvement, hereafter known as LID #2.
- 2) The benefited properties, as listed in the attached Exhibit "A" shall be assessed, by ordinance, with their apportioned share of the improvement, in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 343.
