

RESOLUTION NO. 244

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 238; ADOPTING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1992-93; AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the unanticipated formation of a Local Improvement District by petition of the owners of existing sidewalks, and of one mandatory new sidewalk have caused the need to establish a new fund on the books of the City; and

WHEREAS, a new fund was created by Council resolution in June, 1992, after the adoption of the current Fiscal budget, for the purpose of collecting revenues for construction of public facilities in the city; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AURORA CITY COUNCIL:

A new Fund, entitled "Public Facilities Acquisitions Fund" is hereby established on the books of the City, for the purpose of authorizing expenditures for the construction of public facilities, including, but not limited to, public rest rooms and public parking facilities.

A new Fund, entitled "LID #2 Fund" is hereby established on the books of the city, for the purpose of authorizing expenditures through a Local Improvement District for the repair and/or reconstruction of existing sidewalks, and one mandatory new sidewalk.


The Aurora City Council hereby adopts the Supplemental Budget for Fiscal Year 1992-93, on file in the office of the City Recorder.

The amounts for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 1992 to June 30, 1993, for the purposes shown and appropriated in Resolution No. 238 are hereby amended as follows:


